



**PROPOSED BOND PROJECTS AND ESTIMATED COSTS**



**SECURITY AND TECHNOLOGY UPGRADES**

**\$ 1,350,000**

- Add exterior security cameras throughout the District
- Install new security cameras on school buses
- Install new network switches
- Upgrade the District's wireless system



**TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS**

**\$ 650,000**

- Replace 4 school buses
- Replace 4 small fleet vehicles



**FIELD HOUSE/STADIUM ADDITION AND RENOVATIONS \$ 7,100,000**

- Expand the locker room, training room, coaches' offices, and storage
- Renovate existing weight room
- Upgrade building technology, fire suppression, and life safety systems
- Renovate concession stand and ticket booth with covered canopy
- Replace stadium lights



**PAVING IMPROVEMENTS**

**\$ 650,000**

- Resurface paving at the Field House, dumpster paths, Band Hall entrance, stadium entrance, and Elementary School bus/parent loop

## QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

### Why is the District holding a bond election?

The Board of Trustees unanimously called for a November bond election to fund additional security projects, transportation and parking improvements, and updates to the 1977 Field House.

### How was this proposal developed?

Over the past year, the Board of Trustees reviewed the findings of a District-wide facility assessment report, studied the District's financial situation, considered Texas Education Agency requirements, and prioritized facility improvement projects for voter consideration.

### When was the last successful bond in ISISD?

May 2010

### Will this bond max out the District's tax rate?

No

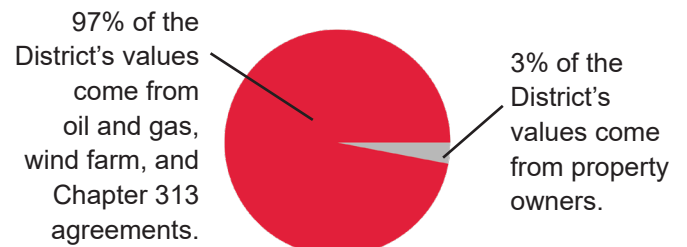
### Can bond money pay for teacher salaries?

No. By law, bond money may not be used for recurring expenses, such as salaries, utilities, and daily supplies.

### Will my taxes go up if I am 65 or older?

No. By law, if you receive an Age 65 or Older Exemption, your homestead taxes cannot be raised above the frozen level unless you make significant improvements or additions to your home. A significant improvement project would be anything beyond normal maintenance and repair, such as building a swimming pool or adding a garage or game room to your home.

### Who can vote?

Any registered voter at least 18 years of age and living within the ISISD boundaries may participate. You must be registered by Tues., Oct. 9.
